

LCA BOOSTER SEAT LAW

Children under age six (GA) and under age eight (TN) are required to be in a car seat or booster seat appropriate for their height and weight and used according to manufacturer's instructions while traveling in a vehicle. Children under age twelve should ride in the rear seat of vehicles. This law applies to all schools involved in transporting children.

Parents of LCA students under age eight are responsible for providing a car seat or booster seat to be stored at the school during the school year. Alternatively, seats can be dropped off on the morning of a field trip or any other event that requires the school to provide transportation for students.
